



Choosing paint colors:

We (by we I mean Jason Sanchez or Keith Anderson and me) can do pretty much any combination of colors you want, or course the trick is choosing the appropriate colors. Here are some options for choosing color:

- 1) This is our favorite: Give me and the painter a general idea on color and paint scheme. For example: "I like grey and light blue with some sort of down tube panel", or even better "painters choice, do what you like". Assuming that you like what you see on the website you will probably like what we come up with for you. Typically we come up with 2 or three options and forward these ideas to you for approval.
- 2) If you want more control over color choice the best way to choose colors is to go to your local auto-body supply shop (search your yellow pages). We can work with any car color codes (all car color cross reference to our paint system). Usually the auto-body supply shops are fairly helpful if you explain what you need and a general color you're looking for. Alternately you can also find the local distributor or the BASF/RM paints. This distributor (usually an auto-body supply shop) will have a variety of color samples for this paint system.
- 3) Have us send you a paint book. Our book has a decent selection of solids and metallics, but no where near the amount of colors you can find using option 2.
- 4) Send us some sort of color sample, anything really as long as its close to the color you want your bike. We'll match it as close as possible. This option requires a bit more work for us (usually a trip to the paint shop) so it costs and additional \$50 for the matching service, however we don't mind doing it and we've color matched some pretty random stuff (dogs, 6-packs, etc...)

Is there any colors/combinations we won't do?

Yes, we reserve to right to refuse certain paint schemes....but so far we haven't had to do this. An example: If you wanted roses and smiley faces painted all over your frame we'd really have to say no. We also don't do any effects like shade shifting paints (looks purple from one angle, and green for another, or some other combination of colors).

Good luck on choosing your color, I'm sure we can work together to come up with something great!
